Legislative Update

- Driven by what backers said was a "tax grab" mentality from some local governments, a new measure terminates the authority to create new alternative joint economic development zones (JEDZs) or substantially modify existing alternative JEDZs.
- A new law authorizes grants for businesses that employ high school students in career exploration internships, equal to 50 percent of the wages paid to the student intern and up to a \$5,000 grant.
